

- Provide regular checkins and career coaching






ROTATIONS

Civil/Building Graduates

There will be three rotations. They will allow you to gain hands-on experience on real projects, and will assist you to build technical, commercial, and leadership capabilities.



IT Graduates

The IT graduate pathway offers a flexible rotation model, providing broad exposure across diverse projects, teams, and functions.

Unlike fixed schedules in other streams, this approach supports tailored development aligned with business needs and individual interests, delivering a rich and varied experience over the two-year program.



HOW TO APPLY?

Applying for our Graduate Program is a straightforward process designed to help you showcase your strengths and career aspirations. Follow the steps below to submit your application:

Step 1

Check your eligibility

Before applying, ensure you meet the following criteria:

- Recently completed (within the last 3 years) or in the final year of a relevant undergraduate or postgraduate degree
- Citizenship or Permanent Residency
- Be willing to do a remote and regional rotation during the program
- Be able to satisfactorily complete a national police check and preemployment medical.

Step 2

Prepare your application

You will need to submit:

- Resume outlining your education, work experience, and extracurricular achievements
- Academic Transcript an unofficial copy is acceptable at the application stage

Step 3

Submit your application

Applications must be submitted online via our Careers Portal by 12 October 2025.

Step 4

Application review and selection

Our recruitment process typically includes:

- Screening Assessment
- Panel Interview/s: in person or on Microsoft Teams
- Reference Checks

We aim to keep you informed at each stage of the process and will notify you of the outcome as soon as possible.




